



## Jane Egbert Brown

January 20, 1924 - August 4, 2018

Jane Kirkpatrick Egbert Brown, 94, wife of Clinton Salt Brown, and a resident of Easton, MD, formerly of Oxford, MD, and Buffalo, NY, died peacefully August 4, 2018, at Hospice House in Easton.

The descendent of American and Canadian pioneers, she was born in Buffalo on January 20, 1924, the daughter of Charles Goggill Egbert and Vivian Kirkpatrick Egbert, and grew up in Niagara Falls, NY. She attended Miss Otis School there, the Buffalo Seminary and graduated from Branksome Hall School, an independent girls' school in Toronto, Ontario.

She worked in a doctor's office for several years before marrying Clinton Salt Brown on October 27, 1951, and becoming a full-time mother and homemaker of homes in Buffalo and in Niagara-on-the Lake, Ontario, until 1980, when they moved to Oxford, MD. She had co-founded Boutique Caprice, a successful Delaware Avenue gift shop in Buffalo. She was active in Trinity Episcopal Church and was a member of the Garrett Club, both in Buffalo, and was a member of Christ Church in Easton. An avid ice skater in her childhood, she was also a life-long sailor on Lake Ontario and on the Chesapeake Bay. A voracious reader, she enjoyed good conversation about everything at parties and around a dinner table with family and friends, who all very much enjoyed her grace, wit, and warm company.

Along with her husband and sisters-in-law Helen Entenman of Naples, FL, and Frances Brown of Bloomfield, CT, she is survived by sons, Clinton Egbert (Alma O'Connell) and Douglas Kirkpatrick (Laurie Counihan) of Buffalo, and Cameron Salt (Dona Tepas) of Naples, FL; and daughter, Alison Rae of Linthicum, MD; eight grandchildren; four great-grandchildren; and many nieces and nephews.

A private graveside service will be held in Oxford Cemetery. A memorial service will be held on Friday, August 17, 2018, at 11 AM at Christ Church, 111 Harrison St. in Easton.

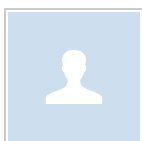
