Jan E. Damas, 82, died December 17, 2003 at his home in Prospect Bay after a long illness.

Born and raised in Poland, Mr. Damas came to the USA after surviving services on the German/Russian front during World War II. Settling in SE Michigan, Mr. Damas worked in corporate accounting for LTV and retired from PPG in 1988. After nearly 50 years in Michigan, Mr. Damas moved to Grasonville after retiring to be close to his grandson.

Mr. Damas was an ardent Catholic who instilled a strong work ethic in his four sons, who he supported generously. Passions included: his grandson, photography, gardening and family gatherings. Jan was particularly fond of spending time at the beach.

Surviving are his wife of 57 years, Rosemarie Damas; four sons, Stan and Kon of Denver, Ray of Grande Ledge, MI and Mike of Grasonville; his sister, Margarete Bartetzki of Germany and his grandson, Stefan Damas.
