Jane Emily McFarlane of Easton, MD, died on Friday, December 1, 2006, at University of Maryland Medical Center in Baltimore. She was 65.

Born in Alton, IL on August 27, 1941, she was the daughter of the late Robert and Ida Brown McFarlane. After graduation from Abraham Clark High School in Roselle, NJ, she attended Simmons College in Boston, MA, graduating with a B.S. in June of 1963. While employed by Enoch Pratt Free Library in Baltimore, MD, she attended Johns Hopkins University and graduated from there with an M.L.A. in June of 1966. From 1966-1968, she worked in England. On her return to the United States, she worked at the Saint Louis (MO) Public Library until 1980. In January of 1981, she moved to Easton to accept a position with the Talbot County Free Library. In August of 1987, she was promoted to the position of Assistant County Librarian.

She is survived by a brother, Paul, of Harrisburg, PA; two nephews, Robert, of Arlington, VA, and James of Wilmington, DE; several aunts and uncles; two grand-nephews; and numerous cousins.

A memorial service will be held on Saturday, December 9, 2006, at 1:00 PM at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., in Easton.
