



Jane Spies Ewing

November 4, 1929 - December 22, 2014

Jane Spies Ewing, devoted wife, mother, sister, and aunt, died in Talbot Hospice on December 22, 2014, in Easton, MD, at the age of 85.

Jane was born on November 4, 1929, in Easton, MD. She graduated from Easton High School in 1946 before attending Union Memorial Nursing School. On April 20th, 1949, she married her only sweetheart, Bill, who stayed by her side for 65 years. She started her family on Hickory Ridge Farm in Easton, MD, before moving to Cedardale Farm near Longwoods, MD, in 1957. With her husband, she raised eight children on the family farm, where she spent her days driving tractors, raising livestock, tending the garden, cooking, and making a full life for her family.

Jane loved spending time with her family and enjoyed quilting, braiding rugs, and restoring antiques. She took pleasure in reading, doing crossword puzzles, and playing scrabble and card games. Jane played the piano and enjoyed listening to old time country music. She delighted in birdwatching, particularly hummingbirds who often fought for her attention just outside her window.

Jane is survived by her husband, Bill; children, Bill Ewing, Jr., David Ewing (Connie), Rosie Johnson, Cindy Steedman (Mark), Althy Dulin (Bunk), Lisa Andrew (Jimmy), Nat Ewing (Sally) and Clive Ewing (Michelle); 19
