Jane Harrison Grafton of Easton, MD, died at Heartfields in Easton on Thursday, October 12, 2006. She was 84.

Born in Woodlawn, MD, on September 25, 1922, she was the daughter of the late Herman Callaway, Sr. and Flora I. Milburn Harrison. She graduated from Catonsville High School, Class of 1939. She was employed with the B & O Railroad in Baltimore, MD. On October 20, 1945 she married Nathan A. Grafton and they made their home in the Baltimore area.
