Jane Stout Jones Henry of Easton, MD, passed away on July 12, 2010, at William Hill Gardens in Easton. She was 97 years old.

Born in Frankfort, KY, on July 30, 1912, she was the daughter of the late, Marcus A. Jones and Sarah E. Thomasson Jones. She moved to Louisville, KY, graduated from The Louisville Girls School in 1930, and attended the University of Louisville. Mrs. Henry was associated with Wakefield-Scearce Galleries in Shelbyville, KY, for twenty-five years and was known as an authority on antique silver.
