



## Jane Learman

Jane S. Learman of Chestertown, MD, died on Wednesday, October 2, 2002, at Corsica Hills Nursing Center in Centreville, MD. She was 84.

Born in Michigan on July 10, 1918, she was the daughter of the late Dean and Josephine Taitt Sharp. She was the wife of Col. Birdsey Lee Learman, a career Army officer who predeceased her on June 27, 1967.

Mrs. Learman attended college for two years at Antioch College in Ohio, and later finished her college education at Delaware State College, graduating with a Bachelor of Science degree in Sociology in January 1970. Mrs. Learman owned a farm with her husband from 1950 until 1997, which was located in Quaker Neck, and personally helped remodel her home on the farm.

For several years, she hosted a radio program on WCTR radio station, called "The People of Our Lives," which involved short interviews with local people about their hobbies and other interests. When in her sixties, Mrs. Learman first learned to play golf and in her later years, she became an avid bridge player, including some duplicate bridge. She was a member of Chester River Yacht and Country Club.

Mrs. Learman is survived by two daughters, Eren Rose of Chestertown, MD, and Linda Learman of Taipei, Taiwan; three grandchildren, Stephanie Requa

of Tulsa, OK, Jennifer Hankins of Austin, TX, and Eren Hendricks of Leesburg, VA; and four great-grandchildren. A daughter, Ann Requa, and a brother, Dr. Thomas Sharp, both predeceased her.

Memorial services will be held on Monday, October 14, 2002, 4:00 P.M., at St. Paul's Episcopal Church on Sandy Bottom Road, near Chestertown, MD. Interment will be private at Arlington National Cemetery beside her husband, to be held at a later date.

In lieu of flowers, contributions may be made to the Chester River Association, 102 South Water Street, Chestertown, MD 21620, in honor of her lifetime love affair with the Chester River. She was a conservationist at heart, both of the River and of the rural way of life in Kent County.
