Jane S. Eustis of Easton, MD, died on Sunday, November 27, 2005 at William Hill Manor in Easton. She was 85.

Born in Easton on October 12, 1920, she was the daughter of the late Capt. Rex B. and Julia Simpson Shaw. Following graduation from Easton High School in 1937, she learned to fly at the Tred Avon Service Operations at Dorsey Webb Farm. At the start of World War II, Jane, by then a skilled pilot working for a Contractor Flight School, began instructing military service pilots, both fighters and bombers. After the war she continued in aviation, becoming a commercial flight instructor and a government flight test pilot.

When in 1953 she met and married John N. Eustis, she retired from commercial aviation work, continuing to fly for pleasure. She accompanied her husband on his several career assignments in Delaware, Maryland, Switzerland, Germany, France and finally Virginia. Upon retirement they returned to the Eastern Shore of Maryland to reside in Easton.

In addition to her aviation work, she loved opera and gardening.

Mrs. Eustis is survived by her husband of fifty-two years, John N. Eustis.

A memorial service will be held on Saturday, December 10, 2005, at 11:00

AM, at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P. A., Easton.

Burial will be at Arlington National Cemetery in Arlington, VA, on Wednesday, December 21, 2005, at 11:00 AM.
