Janet Christie Bickert, 91, passed away on October 30, 2017, at Talbot Hospice House in Easton, MD. Born on February 9, 1926, in Jersey City, NJ, she was the daughter of the late Donald and Isabella Christie McNeill.

Janet grew up in Wood-Ridge, NJ. After high school, she began studies at New York University and launched a busy career with a major insurance brokerage firm in New York City. On March 26, 1949, she married Donald G. Bickert, and they made their home in Ithaca, NY. After moving back to New Jersey, then to Kokomo, IN, then to Newark, DE, they settled in Baltimore, MD, for 23 years.
