



## Janet Louise Auman

Janet Louise Auman of Easton, MD, died on Tuesday, September 22, 2009, at the Memorial Hospital at Easton, MD. She was 62.

Born on June 20, 1947, in Lewiston, ID, she was the daughter of Thorton and Margaret Carroll Moxley. Mrs. Auman was a 1965 graduate of Wendall High School in Wendall, ID.
