Janice Price Keenan of Easton, MD, died Wednesday, September 19, 2001, at William Hill Manor, Easton. She was 73.

Born February 15, 1928, in Easton, she was the daughter of the late James H. and Minnie Bradshaw Price. After graduating from Easton High School in 1945, she attended Nurses Training at Wilmington Memorial Hospital in Wilmington, DE. In 1951, she entered the United States Army Nurses Corp. During the Korean conflict, she was stationed in Japan, where she was involved with transporting and caring for wounded soldiers from field hospitals in Korea to the military hospitals in Japan.

Following her honorable discharge from active duty in 1953, she returned to Easton. In 1957 she married Ralph S. Keenan, Jr., and they made their home in Wilmington, DE. After working as a nurse at various locations, she took a position with the State of Delaware at the Douglas Elementary School in Wilmington, where she specialized in the care of handicapped children. In 1975, she attended West Chester State College in West Chester, PA, where she received a BS degree in nursing. In 1990, she retired after 27 years of service. In 1993, she moved to Easton.

A member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church where she served on the Altar Guild, she was also a member of the EE Streets VFW Post #5118 of

Easton and Post 70 American Legion.

Mrs. Keenan is survived by a sister, Virginia Alton of Easton and several nieces and nephews. In addition to her husband who died in 1986, she was predeceased by a son, Jeffrey J. Keenan, who died in 1997.

Memorial services will be held at William Hill Manor on Sunday, September 30, 2001, at 1:30 PM.
