Jason Stewart Ferreri, 29, of Cordova, MD died on January 29, 2024.

Jason was born in Easton on October 22, 1994 to Stacey and Paul Ferreri. He was the grandson of George and Mary Ferreri (both deceased) and Stewart (deceased) and Barbara Ann (Bobbi) Nash. He attended Chapel District Elementary School, Saints Peter and Paul Middle School and Easton High School where he played football and lacrosse.

When not participating in sports, Jason loved watching sports. The Baltimore Orioles, Baltimore Ravens, Florida State Seminoles and the Washington Capitals were among his favorites. However, the Las Vegas Raiders was "his team." To him, the NFL Draft was like Christmas and Mardi Gras rolled into one. He reviewed stats for the eligible players carefully and would write analyses and recommendations for draft strategies which sadly, the Raiders failed to adopt.

Jason is survived by his parents, Paul and Stacey and siblings: sister Heather Nash Ferreri (Jack Parkinson) ; a brother, Paul Ferreri, Jr. and niece, Ella Parkinson. In addition to his immediate family, Jason enjoyed family gatherings with his 9 aunts and uncles and 13 cousins.

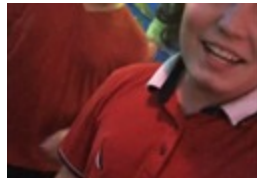
