Jason T. Lee passed away unexpectedly on July 4th, 2026, after a long battle with kidney disease. Born and raised in Talbot County Maryland by his loving parents, James and Holley Lee. Jason was a trusted local business leader for the last 25 years all across the Upper Shore.

Jason fought leukemia at the young age of five and at the time of his passing was the oldest surviving unrelated bone marrow transplant recipient in the United States. He attended Easton High School and obtained an Associates in Technology from Chesapeake College. Soon after graduating he realized his dream of starting a computer business in 1999. He owned and operated Jason's Computer Services, his successful award-winning business, up until the day he passed.

He is survived by his father James T. Lee and his mother and best friend Holley Lee; his two grandmothers, Adrianna Lee and Florence Brewer; his Aunt Nisa and Uncle Tom Macey of Virginia; and many cousins and the family dog, Lorrene.

Jason's hobbies were varied and extensive. Whether it was lending a hand, treating someone he cared about, or investing in a favorite pastime, Jason found happiness in giving more than receiving. He had a love of photography, fast cars, gardening, cooking, nature, Magic the Gathering, traveling, technology, and most of all living life to the fullest. His gift was sharing these hobbies with the local community, family, and friends. At work he spent his time mentoring new technicians and solving his customers' technology issues.

Jason's success allowed him to devote himself to what he loved most—giving back to the community that had supported him for so many years. Through his generosity, whether by sharing his time, donating to local causes, or offering his knowledge and expertise, he touched countless lives. His legacy of kindness and service will continue to be felt throughout the Easton community for years to come.

The family will receive guests and friends on Friday, July 10th, from 5pm until 8pm at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home - Easton. Service and interment will be private. A Celebration of Jason's Life will be held on Saturday, July 11th from 1pm until 5pm at the Easton Elks Lodge #1622, 502 Dutchmans Lane, Easton, MD.

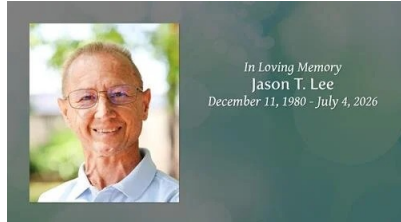

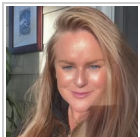

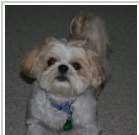
