Jay W. "Jay Bird" Tarmon of Easton, MD died on Monday, October 17, 2005 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 77.

Born March 4, 1928 in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late Joseph Daniel and Doretta Liebowitz Tarmon. After graduating from Tri-County High School in Queen Anne, he entered the U.S. Army, serving in Italy during World War II. During the Korean Conflict he served a second tour of duty as a paratrooper. Following his release from active duty, he worked for Elliott Brothers Trucking. He then began a life long career as a hunting outfitter and later a fishing party Captain. He also raised and trained standard bred horses.

He was a member of the B.P.O. Easton Elks Lodge #1622, E.E. Streets Memorial Post 5118 V.F.W., Easton Moose Lodge #1520, past President of the Maryland Waterfowl Association, and a member of the U.S. Trotting Association.

Mr. Tarmon is survived by his wife, the former Barbara E. Simmons, whom he married April 14, 1956; two children, Lloyd C. Pahlman of Queen Anne, MD, and Linda J. Steele of Voorhees, NJ; four grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held on Monday, October 24, 2005 at 11:00 AM at St.

Mark's United Methodist Church, Easton, MD. Friends may call on Sunday, October 23, 2005 from 6 to 8 PM at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P. A., Easton, MD.
