



## Jean B. Eckstorm

August 20, 1923 - March 4, 2014

Jean Beauchamp Eckstorm died on Tuesday, March 4, 2014. She was 90.

Born in Denton on August 20, 1923, the daughter of Clarence Beauchamp and Araminta Maloney. She graduated from Caroline High School Class of 1940. Then she received her registered Nursing Degree at Memorial Hospital School of Nursing in Easton, MD. She married John William Eckstorm of Stevensville on September 2, 1947. Mrs. Eckstorm became a homemaker until 1964 when she returned to nursing at Anne Arundel General Hospital in Annapolis, MD. She retired in 1981.

She was a member of the alumni at Easton Memorial Hospital School of Nursing and Maryland State Nurses Association. Mrs. Eckstorm volunteered for five years at Anne Arundel General Hospital Auxiliary. She is a member of Hospice of Queen Anne's and Kent Island United Methodist Church in Chester, MD.

Mrs. Eckstorm is survived by her daughter, Robin, and her husband William J. Brechtel of Metairie, LA. She was predeceased by her husband, John Eckstorm; and her sister, Mildred Beauchamp Sullivan.
