QUEENSTOWN, MD: Jean Carry Miller of “My Lord’s Gift Farm”, Queenstown, MD died at Anne Arundel Medical Center, Annapolis, MD on Friday, October 3, 2008. She was 81.

Born March 24, 1927 in Washington, DC, she was the daughter of the late, Charles A. Carry and Francesca Novotny Carry Smith. She was raised in Washington, DC and was a graduate of Woodrow Wilson High School and then attended Edgewood Park Finishing School for two years. She married W. C. “Bill” Miller, Jr. and they resided in Washington, DC, where she was a homemaker. They moved to “My Lord’s Gift Farm”, Queenstown, MD in 1971 where she was still residing at the time of her death. Mr. Miller died in 1978.
