



## Jeanette H. Davis

March 19, 1918 - December 8, 2008

Jeanette H. Davis of Easton, MD died on Monday, December 8, 2008 at the Memorial Hospital at Easton. She was 90.

Born March 19, 1918 in Cordova, MD, she was the daughter of the late Clyde and Gertrude Lednum Hopkins. In 1934 she graduated from Cordova High School. During her working career, she was a telephone operator for C&P Telephone Company, a secretary for Christ Church St. Michaels, a bank teller for MD National Bank in Salisbury and St. Michaels, bookkeeper and secretary for Dixon House, Red Star Bus Service, now known as Trailways, and Bethany House in Cordova.

Her husband, Thomas J. Davis, whom she married November 24, 1937, died January 29, 2004.

A member of the Ladies of the Elks, she was also a member of the Ladies of the Moose, and a former member of Christ Episcopal Church, St. Michaels. In her spare time she enjoyed gardening, cooking, canning and being mother and wife.

Mrs. Davis is survived two children, Mary Davis Granger and her husband O. Bain "Sonny" of Neavitt, and James M. Davis and his friend Lynne Price of Easton; a brother, Charles H. Hopkins of Dover, DE; two grandchildren, Jared

W. Davis and Justin T. Davis; and a great grandson, Jaxson J. Davis. She was predeceased by two brothers, Kenneth L. Hopkins and Marion F. Hopkins; and a sister, Doris H. Patrick.

Funeral services will be held on Monday, December 15, 2008 at 2:00 PM at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, where friends may call one hour prior to the service.
