Jeanette Isabel Compton died on September 7, 2010 at Corsica Hills Nursing Home. She was 85.

Born on March 31, 1925 in Chester, she was the daughter of the late, Dewey F. and Eleanor Thomas Jones. Mrs. Compton attended school in Chester.
