Jeanette W. Fehsenfeld of Easton, MD died on Thursday, August 28, 2003 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. She was 82.

Born August 26, 1921 in Talbot County, she was the daughter of the late Leo Robert and Clara Eberhard Willis. After graduating from Easton High School in 1938, she attended Goldey Beacom Business School and then took a secretarial position with E.I. Dupont in Wilmington, DE. She later returned to Easton where she worked as a secretary for Easton Wholesale Candy Company and then for the Honorable Harry E. Clark until her retirement in the 1980's.

A member of Grace Lutheran Church in Easton, she was also a member of the Memorial Hospital Auxiliary and the AARP. She was instrumental in organizing the Free Tax Assistance Program for Senior Citizens. Her loves included walking, gardening, reading, traveling and her family.

Mrs. Fehsenfeld's first husband, George H. Eaton, died in 1972, and her second husband, Arthur Louis Fehsenfeld, died in 1979. She is survived by a brother, Ralph Willis and his wife Iris of Trappe; a sister, Betty Pinkston of Springbrook, Wisconsin; a brother, Lawrence Willis, died July 12, 2001; her son, Paul Gary Eaton and his wife Dawn of Cambridge; two daughters, Susan F. Davis and her husband Bob of Trappe and Betsy F. Van Auken and her

husband Doug of Baltimore; and six grandchildren, Timothy John Eaton, Annie , Luke , and Lindsay Davis, Wil and Ezra Van Auken.
