



## Jean Grant Ainsworth

March 5, 1929 - May 4, 2008

Jean Grant Ainsworth of Easton, MD went home to be with the Lord on Sunday, May 4, 2008 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. She was 79.

Born March 5, 1929 in Easton, MD, she was the daughter of the late Harry and Ruth Morris Bramble. In 1946 she graduated from Easton High School. She was a clerical bookkeeper for most of her working life, for Neatons Tire Center and then Dr. Robert Smoloski until her health prevented her from working.

On January 1, 1951 she married Paul F. Grant. Mr. Grant died in July 1974. She then in 1975 married Harry Ainsworth who died in 1998.
