Jeanne Maxwell, 57, of Centreville, MD, died on November 12, 2000, at Johns Hopkins Hospital in Baltimore, MD.

Born in New Castle, PA, she is the daughter of William and Jennifer Buiney. She spent her formative years in New Castle and received her formal education graduating from the following colleges, Indiana University in PA with her B.S.; Loyola in Baltimore with a Masters; and was attending Washington College in Chestertown in pursuit of a Masters in Psychology. She worked at the Benedictine School in Ridgley as a counselor for the past seven years. Mrs. Maxwell married George A. Maxwell, M.D., and through his occupation as a professor, they traveled the world.

Mrs. Maxwell was a member of various organizations such as the St. Paul's Episcopal Church where she was a member of the choir for 32 yrs. and President of the Episcopal Church Women. She was Past President of the Garden Club of Centreville, a member of Zeta Tau Alpha Society, and president of the Rumbai-Suntra Women's Golf and Tennis Clubs in Indonesia. Academically, she was a member of the Chi Sigma Iota Honorary Counseling Academic and Professional Honor Society International and the Psi Chi National Honorary Society in Psychology. She also served as hostess for Princess Anne. In her spare time, in addition to the above, she enjoyed gardening and being with family and friends.

In addition to her parents, she is survived by her husband of 32 years, George A. Maxwell, M.D. of Centreville, MD; a son, Robert William Maxwell of Fairfax, VA; and five step-grandchildren. Memorial services will be held at 11 a.m. on Wednesday, November 15 at St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Centerville, with interment in Chesterfield Cemetery in Centreville.
