Turner Eyer of Chestertown, MD, died Saturday, February 9, 2008 at Dorchester General Hospital. She was 78.

Jean T. Eyer was born March 13, 1929 in Chestertown, MD, the daughter of the late, Frank Catlin Turner and Nannie Judefind Turner. Mrs. Eyer was a 1946 graduate of Chestertown High School. She attended Washington College for two years and was a 1952 graduate of the Delaware Hospital School of Nursing. She then married Robert F. Hansen, a graduate of the Naval Academy, in Chestertown at Christ United Methodist Church. With the military life came much traveling, living in eight states and two foreign countries, the Phillipines and Japan. Mrs. Eyer worked as a registered nurse for Kent and Queen Anne's Hospital, Easton Memorial Hospital and as a nurse in Pensicola, Fl. She also worked for Kent Hospice, as a nurse's aid at Magnolia Hall and as a teacher's aid in Kennedyville School. She volunteered for the Special Olympics and attended church at Christ United Methodist Church in Chestertown. Her interests included bird and squirrel watching, crocheting, crossword puzzles, reading, playing scrabble, writing letters, crab feasts, Gregory Peck movies, listening to Tom Jones, Kenny Rogers, Andy Williams and Nat King Cole. She loved to go camping with her family, traveling and taking care of her two cats, Buddy and Izzy. Most of all she enjoyed spending time with her family. She was also a member of the Rock Hall garden club.

In addition to her parents she was preceded in death by her husband, Lt. Cmdr. Robert Frederick Hansen; one daughter, Nancy Christine Hansen and one sister, Anne Turner Landry.
