Jeff Daniel Wolff, 58, of Centreville, Maryland departed from this life to his eternal resting home on November 9, 2024. Thus, ending a courageous 15-year battle from the effects of a malignant brain tumor and subsequent treatments.

Jeff resided in Queen Anne's County for the last 5 years of his life, to be closer to the support and care of his Mother and Sister. Prior to this, he resided in Salisbury, MD, where he taught middle-school for Worcester County Public Schools. Jeff graduated from Salisbury University in 2004 with a Bachelor's Degree in Education. Prior to his degree, Jeff spent many years in the concrete and construction field. He moved to Berlin to not only take classes at Salisbury University, but to also provide care for his elderly Grandparents.

Jeff was born on January 28, 1966 in Washington, D.C. He was the firstborn child of three eventual children to Walter Louis Wolff Jr. and June Lee Wolff (nee Fortune).

Jeff was a gorgeous toddler with dirty blonde curls, which he later recreated with the help of a beautician during his 1980's "hair-band run". Jeff's happiest times were spent either playing the guitar or fishing. All family gatherings included Jeff playing guitar alongside his father and brother, which brought

Jeff so much joy. His next favorite thing to do was go out of Snug Harbor in his boat and fish for flounder. For years he was the “sought-after fish cleaner” at Fisherman’s Marina in West Ocean City.

Jeff never married, but he had several significant close relationships that he always cherished. His next leading lady was Jazmin, his beloved dog and sidekick for two decades.

Jeff was an incredibly talented guitarist and played in many bands earlier in his life, but transitioned to solo gigs over the past 25 years. He possessed a beautiful singing voice. He was always the life of the party and source of entertainment. He was also a skilled carpenter, assisting his brother-in-law with many construction projects around their home. He loved Assateague Island and passed this love onto his niece and nephew with many trips by boat and car to enjoy collecting snails, shells, and swimming.

Jeff had a large friend group, most of whom were from his childhood days in Monrovia, MD. Jeff graduated from Linganore High School in 1984.

Jeff is survived by his Mother, June Fortune Wolff, his siblings, Glen Christian Wolff (Katie) and Kimberly Ann Hazuda (Scott) and his beloved niece and nephew Caroline Lucille Hazuda and Reed Scott Hazuda. He was predeceased by his father Walter Louis Wolff Jr and by both sets of Grandparents.
