



Jeffery Cole Frazier

June 11, 1947 - April 9, 2009

Jeffery Cole Frazier of Stevensville, MD died on April 9, 2009 at his home after a short illness surrounded by his loving family. He was 61 years old.

Mr. Frazier was born in Michigan on June 11, 1947 to the late William Ray Frazier and Hazel Peck. He graduated from Annapolis High School, the University of Maryland and Johns Hopkins University where he received his engineering degree. He married Ann Marie Watson on March 15, 1969, Mr. Frazier served in the Army from 1969 to 1972 during the Vietnam War. After being honorably discharged, he went to work for the Sweetheart Cup Company. He then worked for NSA and for 10 years for the FCC before retiring in February 2009 due to disability. He loved spending time with his family and grandchildren and enjoyed tinkering with cars.

Mr. Frazier is survived by his wife, Ann Marie Frazier of Stevensville, MD; two daughters, Jennifer VanDermolen of Stevensville, MD and Heather Espinal of Chester, MD; a sister, Elena Gilden of Annapolis; two brothers, Joel Frazier of Georgia and Eric Frazier of Millersville, MD; and three grandchildren, Terrance, Tyler, and Kevin.
