Jeffrie Charles O'Toole Zellmer, 73 of Queenstown went to heaven on Thursday, August 20th, 2015.

Jeff was born to the late Kathleen and Warren Zellmer in Cleveland, OH on October 22, 1941.

Jeff has had a long and successful career. Jeff was active in Maryland politics since 1966 running campaigns and fundraising. Jeff has been active in business and community groups having served on the Board of Director of the Montgomery County Chamber of Commerce, Board member of the United Way in Montgomery County and Queen Anne's County and active in the VFW, American Legion and the Lions Club (past President). He served as Chairman of the Montgomery County Revenue Authority under County Executive Charles Gilchrist. Most recently, Jeff served as Vice President of Government and Community affairs for the Maryland Retailers Association. He has worked for the association since 1995. Most notably in 2003, Governor Parris Glendenning appointed him to fill a vacancy on the bench of the Orphans' Court of Queen Anne's County. Jeff is survived by his wife Sharon Lipsius; daughters Elizabeth Lee and Courtney; grandchildren Bradley, Ryan and Patrick; and sister Kathleen O'Toole Zellmer; stepchildren Will Powell and Danielle Powell; step grandchildren Kirsten, Paige and Tess.

Jeff was an avid golfer who participated in numerous charity tournaments over the years. In his later years, he had a passion for international travel with his wife Sharon. They enjoyed visiting various countries across the globe including a dream vacation to Africa where they were married while on safari.

A memorial service and burial will be held at 2:00pm on September 11 at Old Wye Church, Maryland followed by a celebration of Jeff's life with his close family and vast extended family of friends and loved ones.
