Jeffry A. Miles of Easton, MD died on Sunday, October 5, 2008 at Dorchester General Hospital, Cambridge, MD.

Born in Easton, July 30, 1968, he was the son of Vernon E., Sr. and Rose Anita Swartz Miles. A 1987 graduate of Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic School, he worked for Floors by Meredith and then formed his own carpet business, retiring in 2004 due to his health.

As a youth, he was a Cub Scout, a Boy Scout, and played lacrosse and soccer for Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic School. He was a former member of the Easton Volunteer Fire Department, and the Sts. Peter & Paul Men and Boys Church Choir where he was a member. An avid sportsman, he was an official Bayside Umpire.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Miles is survived by his son, Jimmy Miles of Easton; one sister, Rebecca Baney and her husband Chris of Preston; three brothers, Vernon E.
