Jenevie Cohee Russ of Parsonsburg, formerly of Easton, died at the Salisbury Rehab and Nursing Center on Friday, January 18, 2002. She was 89.

Born in Talbot County on September 10, 1912, she was the daughter of the late Asa B. and Cora Snively Cohee. She was a deputy clerk for the Clerk of the Circuit Court in Easton. She was a lifelong resident of Talbot County until 1995 when she moved to her granddaughter's home in Parsonsburg.

Her husband, Alfred Edward Russ, whom she married in 1936, died on August 14, 1993.

Mrs. Russ was a member of the Easton Church of the Brethren and attended the Salisbury Church of the Brethren.
