Mrs. Jennie Harrison (Nana Bug or Aunt Jetty) passed away on Wednesday, July 8, 2020. She was 94 years old.

Born on December 17, 1925 in Tallassee, Alabama, she was the daughter of the late Harry and Mezzelie Harrison. She married Joe H. Harrison in 1944 and eventually moved her family to Queen Anne, MD and then to Easton, MD after their children were out of school. Joe passed away in July 1989.

She was a breast cancer survivor (1970). She loved spending time with her family and was known for cooking a full course meal in less than twenty minutes for any family member that just happened to stop by.

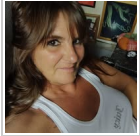
