



Jennifer Wheeler

October 21, 1941 - September 28, 2024

Born on October 21, 1941, in Berkeley, CA, Jennifer Wheeler passed away in Easton, MD, on September 28, 2024. In 1946, her parents, Ahlborn Wheeler and Marjorie Merrow, moved their family to Arden, DE. After she graduated from the Friends School in Wilmington, DE, she attended the University of Delaware for a year in 1959 before transferring in 1960 to the prestigious Philadelphia Museum College of Art, where she graduated in 1964.

She moved to Easton in 1966 after falling in love with its charm and lived there for the rest of her life. A creative spirit, Jenny was both a talented artist and a professional guitarist in country and western bands in Delaware and Maryland. In the Easton area, Jenny had a notable career as a public school art teacher for almost 30 years, and she was widely loved by two generations of local students.

Jenny never married and had no children. She was an avid animal lover, who tamed a wild racoon as a pet as a child in Arden, and who was noted as a devoted cat lover since 1964.

Jenny was a sweet and loving person with a beautiful spirit who will be terribly

missed. She was loved for her gentle, good-natured, cheerful disposition. She was a lifelong fan of Elvis Presley, whom she saw perform live twice in 1956. As a teenager, in her bedroom in Arden, she painted a marvelous wall mural of Elvis striking three different dramatic poses.

She was a faithful Christian who was an enthusiastic congregant of the Fellowship Life Church of Ridgely, MD.

Jenny is survived by her loving and devoted brother, Wolcott Wheeler of Tarrytown, NY; her sister Beverly Weaver of Manchester, MO; and her nephew John Michael Wheeler of Treasure Island, FL. Her younger brother John passed away in 2009.
