



Jeremiah Frederick Kratz

August 1, 1931 - February 25, 2017

Jeremiah Frederick Kratz, 85, of Trappe, MD, died on Saturday, February 25, 2017, at Talbot Hospice House. He was born in New Braunfels, TX, on August 1, 1931, son of the late Alvin Kratz and Minnie Baer Kratz.

He received a Bachelor of Arts at Southwest Texas State Teacher's College, a Masters in History at the University of Texas and was a Public Affairs Fellow at Stanford University. In 1950, he began his 44 year career in the United States Air Force, retiring as a Major.

Also, Mr. Kratz was employed as a contractor and Senior Analyst with the Dept. of Energy, Office of Arms Control and Nonproliferation, Division of High Energy Physics. He also worked for the U.S. Atomic Energy Commission/Dept. of Energy, Office of Special Projects, Division of International Affairs. He was also employed with the U.S. Air Force Intelligence Agency, working as a Human Resources Intelligence Officer and Intelligence Operations Technician with assignments at the Pentagon, National Photographic Interpretation Center, the Defense Intelligence Agency at Dover and Bolling Air Force Base and was a recruiter for the Air Force Academy. Mr. Kratz was also a director for the Cooperative Education Program and an academic advisor at Chesapeake College.

He was a loving husband, father, grandfather, and great-grandfather, as well

as an environmentalist, nature lover and gardener.

He is survived by his wife of 64 years, Dorothy Schaefer Kratz; his children, James Kratz (Lynn), Catherine Bornhoeft (John), Christina Warren, Cynthia Phillips (Scott) and Samuel Kratz (Pari); eleven grandchildren; and three great-grandchildren.

A chapel service will be held on Thursday, March 2, 2017, at 1PM ,at the Eastern Shore Veterans Cemetery in Hurlock.
