



## Jerome Millin Hinkle

June 22, 1942 - December 12, 2023

Jerome “Jerry” Millin Hinkle departed peacefully in the early morning of December 12th, 2023, at the Talbot Hospice House in Easton, Maryland.

Jerry was born on June 22, 1942, in West Hickory, Pennsylvania, the eldest son of the late Jane and Jerome Hinkle. He found his way to Phillips Exeter Academy in the fall of 1958, becoming part of the graduating class of 1961. As a freshman, he achieved a remarkable feat by setting a javelin throwing record that still stands to this day – an astounding 207’ 5”. Jerry then attended Yale (class of 1965) where he continued his passion for track and field and once again excelled at javelin throwing, setting another record that he held for eleven years. He has left an indelible mark on the sport.

Professionally, Jerry distinguished himself as a skilled trader at Lehman Bros. and Sanford C. Bernstein & Co. and various other prestigious institutions. He was admired by friends and colleagues for his dedication, sharp intellect and professionalism. Retiring to Florida, Jerry found joy in simple pleasures – watching horse racing and taking serene walks on the beach with his beloved wife, Diana Brian, who will always cherish the memories they created together.

Tragically, Jerry was preceded in death by his brother, Ron, and beloved son, Jerome Jr. He is survived by his brothers Den, Ken, and his devoted son, Bill,

and his grandsons, Gray and Brooks.

He has also left a profound impact and enduring mark on Diana's children and grandchildren: Natalie Dent and her children, Audrey and Tripp, with whom Jerry had a special bond; Christopher Brian and his wife Ellen Mathias and their two little ones, Vivian and Lucille; and Alexandra Brian whom he kindly mentored.
