Jerome C. Lowery of Chester died on August 20, 2001 at his home. He was 49.

Born on February 5, 1952 in Queenstown, he was the son of Catherine Skaggs and Robert C. Lowery of Chester. He graduated from Queen Anne's County High School in the class of 1970. On November 7, 1970 he married Teresa Quimby of Grasonville. Mr. Lowery started working on the water with his father. From 1970 to 1985 he owned and operated the Kent Island Mobil Station. While still self-employed he started working for the Queen Anne's County Sheriff Department for one year. He then went to work for the Anne Arundel County Sheriffs Department and retired due to health reasons on January 1, 2001. He was a member of the Fraternal Order of Police Lodge #106, and the Bay Country Moose Lodge in Queenstown.

In addition to his wife and parents, he is survived by two sons, Trent and Troy Lowery of Chester; two daughters, Tiffany Dudley of Chester and Pam Blunt of Easton; a sister, Robin O'Donnell of Grasonville; and two grandchildren, Erin and Chase Lowery of Chester.

Memorial services will be held 2:00pm at Kent Island United Methodist Church on Thursday, August 23, 2001. Burial will be private.
