May 10, 1936 - April 4, 2022

Jerry Kenneth Bell was born in Washington, DC, on May 10, 1936, and died on April 4, 2022, in Easton, MD.

Jerry grew up in southern MD and later lived in Sterling, VA, Manilla, the Philippines, Arlington, VA, and Vienna, VA, before settling in Easton in 1992. He served in the U.S. Air Force from 1956-1960, including a tour of duty in Japan. He worked for the CIA for many years before transferring to the Office of Personnel Management where he retired from Federal service in 1992. Through his work he traveled around the world twice and later enjoyed traveling throughout the U.S., Canada, and Europe in his retirement.

He and his wife, Ellen, particularly enjoyed Paris, as well as visiting family in Germany. He was a Mason, loved fishing, the beauty of the outdoors and many sports, but was particularly fond of soccer. He co-founded Loudon County (Virginia) youth soccer and spent many years coaching kids in both Sterling and Arlington.

Jerry is predeceased by his father Roger Bell, mother Dorothy Bell Alvey, and brothers Lester (Buddy) and Daniel (Danny) Bell.

He leaves behind his wife Ellen; children Paul (Birgit), John (Theresa), Heather and Nathan Andrew (Andy) West (Kate). Other surviving family

members include Phillip and Jenny West, eleven grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren.

A graveside service with military honors will take place at the Maryland Eastern Shore Veteran's Cemetery in Hurlock, MD.
