



## Jesse Whalen

July 16, 1934 - December 8, 2010

Jesse George Whalen of Sudlersville, MD died Wednesday, December 8 at Easton Memorial Hospital in Easton, MD. He was 76.

Born July 16, 1934 in Chester, PA, he was the son of the late, Jesse Sharp Whalen and Fredericka Sigel Whalen. Mr. Whalen worked as a Millwright for Local Union 1545 and he was also a standardbred horse trainer. He moved to Sudlersville in 1951 and has been a resident of Queen Anne's county ever since.
