



Jimmie Lee Dell

January 13, 1936 - November 12, 2013

Jimmie Lee Dell of Centreville, MD, died at Queen Anne's County Hospice Center, Centreville, MD, on Tuesday, November 12, 2013. He was 77.

Born in Kiowa, KS, he was the son of the late Walter A. and Dorothy Mae Miner Dell. He grew up in Oklahoma City, OK, and was a graduate of Oklahoma University, a member of the Phi Beta Kappa fraternity, and the ROTC Program. After graduating, he worked in Oil Geology and later became an officer in the U.S. Army from 1957-1963. He then went to work for the Naval Criminal Investigative Service from 1963 – 1986. After retiring from NCIS, he worked for MSN Security doing background investigations until 2003.

He was a volunteer of the Anne Arundel Police Dept. and the Queen Anne County Sheriff's Aux. Dept. In 2006, he moved to Centreville where he enjoyed golf and traveling internationally with his wife.

Mr. Dell is survived by his wife, Anita Rose Dell of Centreville; two sons, Christopher Dell and Donald Dell; two stepdaughters, Theresa Seeger, and Tammy Cushley; two stepsons, Thomas Seeger and Fred Seeger; a brother, Walter L. "Buster" Dell; and nine grandchildren.
