Joan Adams Meehan, 79, of Easton, MD, died peacefully at home on Friday, February 7, 2014, surrounded by her family.

Joan was born on November 7, 1934, in Baltimore MD, the daughter of the late Pius Adams and Agatha Benesunas Adams. She graduated at the top of her class from Mt. St. Agnes College and received her nursing degree from Union Memorial Hospital in Baltimore. She went on to earn a Master's Degree in Nursing from Salisbury University.
