December 31, 1927 - August 12, 2013

Joan P. Spitzer died on August 12, 2013, at University of Maryland Easton Shore at Easton from complications suffered from a stroke on August 9, 2013. She was 85.

The former Joan Patricia Smith was born in New York City on December 31, 1927, daughter of the late Rev. John Patrick Smith and Norine McNamara. She attended Ladycliff Academy and Good Counsel College and was assistant buyer at J.C. Penney in New York.

She married the late Carlton E. Spitzer on July 15, 1948. Mr. Spitzer died on May 4, 2013.
