



Joanna Catherine Rosette

July 14, 1931 - June 29, 2013

Joanna Catherine Rosette died Saturday, June 29, 2013, at the Talbot Hospice House in Easton. She was 81.

Born in Washington, DC, on July 14, 1931, to Onofrio and Carmela Smiroldo, Joanna was the seventh of nine children. After attending Anacostia High School in Washington, she worked as a key punch operator for the Government Employees Insurance Company.

She married Kenneth L. Rosette at St. Francis Xavier Catholic Church on June 30, 1957. She continued working until giving birth to their first child, Kenneth, Jr., in August 1959. The new family then moved to Blacksburg, VA, where her husband studied engineering at Virginia Tech. She was honored by the Co-operative Education Department for her moral support of her husband's college education.

The family settled in the Seabrook, MD, area where Joanna was a dedicated mother and wife, providing a wonderful home for her family. She and her husband resided there for 22 years and had two more children, Julia and Keith. After living eight years in Dunkirk, MD, she and her husband retired to Cordova, MD in 1996.

Joanna follows her son, Kenneth, Jr., who died in 1978, into the arms of the

Lord.

She is survived by her husband, Kenneth L. Rosette of Cordova; her daughter, Julia J. Green and son-in law, Brian, of Cordova, her son, Keith A. Rosette, and daughter-in-law, Theresa, of Purcellville, VA; and five grandchildren, Lindsey and Mitchell Green, Luke, Paul, and Daniel Rosette; three brothers, Joseph, Charles, and Michael Smiroldo; and her sister, Sara Fleshman, and brother-in-law, John.

A visitation will held on Tuesday, July 2, 2013, from 6pm to 8 pm at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., 200 South Harrison St., Easton, MD, 21601, where closing prayers and rosary will be offered at 7:45 pm.

A Funeral Liturgy will be celebrated on Wednesday, July 3, 2013, at 2 pm at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Cordova, MD. Interment will follow in St. Joseph's Catholic Church Cemetery.
