Jo Anne Tobin of Wilmington, DE died on Tuesday, February 26, 2013 after battling cancer. She was 63.

JoAnne was born on December 6, 1949 in Indiana. She was the daughter of the late Jack and Jane Williams. After having moved frequently during her grade school years due to her father's military service, in 1967, JoAnne graduated from St. Mary's High School in Phoenix, Arizona. On July 5, 1969, she was married to Edwin James Tobin, Jr. and resided in California. During 1980, the family moved back east to Maryland where JoAnne was a homemaker as well as worked as the bookkeeper for the family farm. In 2005, JoAnne moved to Wilmington, DE and pursued her dream of getting a college diploma. She graduated from University of Delaware with a Bachelors of Arts degree as Magna Cum Laude in 2009. JoAnne enjoyed hiking, traveling the world and volunteering.

She is survived by her daughter, Kristen Larrimore of Chestertown, MD, and two brothers, Mike Williams of Oakdale, CA and Ralph Williams of Phoenix, AZ.

She was preceded in death by a sister, Patti Williams, and a brother, Jimmy Williams.
