



## Joan V. Weber

October 5, 1931 - October 4, 2011

Joan Viola Weber of Chester, MD died on Tuesday, October 4, 2011 at the Shady Grove Adventist Hospital, one day before her 80th birthday.

Born in Hanover, PA on October 5, 1931, she was the daughter of the late John Bollinger and Viola Bowman Bollinger. She was baptized on January 31, 1932. After her marriage to Rev. Albert "Gus" L. Weber, the couple moved first to Baltimore, and then later to Kensington, where she worked for the National Institutes of Health as a secretary until 1981. The Webers moved to Fallston to establish Holy Communion Lutheran Church and Mrs. Weber went to work at the Aberdeen Proving Grounds, until 1990. The Webers then retired to Ocean Pines, where she volunteered at the Community Library. In 2005, the Webers moved to Stevensville, and for the past five years Mrs. Weber has resided at the National Lutheran Home in Rockville.

She is survived by her daughters, Anna Kathleen "Kathy" Trotter (Don) of Stevensville, MD, Margaret "Margie" Joan Reilly (Patrick) of Chester, and Laurie Anne Weber Rickett (Paul) of Crofton; and two grandsons, Christopher Reilly and Elliott Reilly. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Albert L. Weber; and her sister, Mary Lou Jensen.

A memorial service will be held at 11:00 am on Monday, October 10, 2011 at the Trinity Lutheran Church, 11200 Old Georgetown Rd., North Bethesda, MD.
