Jody Jean O'Brien of Easton died on Saturday, June 25, 2011 at the Talbot Hospice House. She was 51.

Born on February 4, 1960 in Keene, NH she was the daughter of James J. and Audrey A. O'Brien. After graduating from Easton High School in 1978, she then attended Chesapeake College and graduated with an associate's degree with two majors, Physical Education and Recreation. In 1982, Jody graduated from Keene State College in Keene, NH with a bachelor's degree in Sports Management. Prior to moving to Easton in 2006, Jody lived in Keene, NH and worked for IMTEC and was an international sales person whose territory covered Asia. She then went to work for Polyonics in NH, also in sales and her territory covered the United States, Mexico, Canada, Latin America, and Europe.

She was the past president of the Keene State College Alumni Association, and a member of the Coastal Conservation Association of Maryland.
