Joe Shultz was born in Kulpmont, PA on May 30, 1939, to the late Joseph J. Shultz and Anna Theresa Shovlin Shultz. He attended Mount Carmel Catholic high school, graduating class of 1956. After high school he joined the United States Air Force and specialized in communications. He lived in Turkey for two years before returning to the States. While in the US, he lived in various locations, including Nebraska for four years, Hawaii for four years, Rochester, New York for two years, Fort Meade (NSA) for four years, and finally Andrews Air Force Base, from where he retired in 1986. He moved to the Eastern Shore of Maryland in 2003, residing in Easton. On August 25, 1962, he married Cynthia M. Spencer, who predeceased him in 2005.

Mr. Shultz is a member of the VFW, the Air Force Sergeant association, the Knights of Columbus and the hospital auxiliary. He enjoys reading, sports, and sports games.

Mr. Shultz is survived by three children, Marianne Shultz, Michael J. Shultz (Heidi) and Robert S. Shultz, a granddaughter, Anna Grace; and a brother John E. Shultz (Mary).

The family will receive guests and friends on Saturday, September 12, 2026, from 10:30am until 12:30pm at Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church, 1210 S. Washington St. A Mass of Christian Burial will immediately follow at 12:30pm. Interment with military honors at Arlington National Cemetery, alongside his wife, will take place at a later date.
