Joel Brandes, formerly of Chestertown, MD, and Coconut Creek, FL, died on Thursday, September 1, 2016, at Union Memorial Hospital in Baltimore. He was 79.

The son of David and Mary Brandes, he proudly served his country with the US Navy. He later attended Hofstra University and enjoyed a career as an automotive aftermarket executive, retiring in 1992. In 1961, he married Francine Prospect, who survives him.
