John William “Johnny” Beck of Chester, MD, died at his home early Monday morning, July 9, 2012. He was 78.

Born on December 24, 1933, in Paris, IL, he was the son of the late Opal and John M. Beck. He graduated from Bethesda Chevy Chase High School. He served in the U.S. Army from 1956 to 1958, until he was called home for his mother’s death. He married Jeanne Marie Judge in 1959. He worked as a painting contractor for 11 years. He then worked as a supervisor for Ward Machinery Company for 27 years until his retirement.
