Jack Bennett died at his home in Oxford, MD on Thursday, February 14, 2002 of cancer at the age of 77.

Born in Rochester, NY, he was the son of the late Vincent S. and Helen Holden Bennett. He was a graduate of Harley School and Dartmouth University with an M.S. in Civil Engineering. He served in the Navy in World War II and then in the Naval Reserve until his retirement. He spent four years working in Alaska where he and his family had relocated and then was associated with the Rochester construction firm of Stewart and Bennett until his retirement. He was a world class skeet champion having won the National Five Man Championship in 1972 along with numerous other awards.

Preceding him in death were his first wife, Mary Coye Bennett and a brother, Robert H. Bennett.

Mr. Bennett is survived by his wife, Joan Belleville Bennett of Oxford and his children, Peter Bennett of Rochester, NY, Andrew and Sophie Bennett of Victor, NY and Polly Bennett of Denver, CO; a brother, Richard and his wife, Ruth; a sister, Jane Morris of Rochester, NY; stepchildren, Catherine Nonake of Kona, HI, Jackie Kinney of Easton, MD, Marine Sgt. Maj. W.T. Kinney and his wife, Julie of CA; eight grandchildren; a great-grandchild and several nieces and nephews.

A Memorial service will be held on March 2, 2002 at 11:00 AM at the Church of the Holy Trinity in Oxford, MD, followed by a reception at the church. There will be a second reception at the Talbot Rod and Gun Club in Easton at 2:00 PM that same afternoon.

Interment will be in Honeoye Falls, NY at a later date.
