John Hugo Berglund of Chestertown, MD passed away suddenly on Wednesday, October 29, 2003 at Heron Point. He was 90.

Born on April 20, 1913 on Staten Island, New York, he was the son of the late Adolph and Lucinda Jacobson Berglund. He was a graduate of Curtis High School, class of 1931 and he attended Wagner College graduating in 1935 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Chemistry. He went to work with Esso, now Exxon/Mobile, as a Marine Chemist in the Research and Development Division and retired as senior research chemist in 1971. Upon retirement he and his wife moved to Whispering Pines, North Carolina where he enjoyed gardening, woodcarving, golf, and world traveling.

He was a 15-year member of the Whispering Pines Rescue Squad. He had served on the Wagner College Board of Trustees and was a member of the Marine Chemist Society. Mr. and Mrs. Berglund resided in Chestertown, Md. for the past 10 years where they were members of Emmanuel Episcopal Church.

His devoted wife of 65 years, Gladys Winters Berglund predeceased him June 11 of 2003.

Mr. Berglund is survived by two daughters, Lucinda J. Simmons and her

husband, Robert of Keswick, VA and Phyllis L. Jones of Salisbury, MD; a son, John M. Berglund and his wife, Katy of Ashville, NC; six grandchildren and thirteen great grandchildren.
