



## Dr. John E. Bezjak

June 19, 1951 - July 8, 2024

Dr. John E. Bezjak, 73, died in Easton, MD on July 8, 2024. John was born in New York City on June 19, 1951. He received his undergraduate degree from Cornell University, going on to receive a Masters of Nursing and Doctorate in Public Health from Loma Linda University. He was commissioned in the U.S. Public Health Service and served with the Indian Health Service in Arizona. After an honorable discharge, he relocated to Salisbury, MD where he was appointed as a professor in nurse practitioner programs in Maryland and Delaware. John joyfully taught music and tennis to his children. He is preceded in death by his father, Branko and mother, Sava. He is survived by his loving wife, Milena; twin sons, Gabriel and Matthew; daughter, Johanna (Joseph); sister, Mary; and nephews, Paul and Andrew.

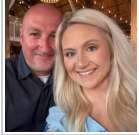
