John K. Billings, age 82, of Chestertown, MD died on October 29, 2010, at his home near Chestertown. Mr. Billings was born in Philadelphia, PA on June 15, 1928. He was the son of the late John H. Billings and Sibyl Billings. He served in the U.S. Marine Corps from 1946 to 1948 and graduated from Drexel University in 1952. He went on to receive his Masters Degree from Drexel and his MBA from Penn State. After college, he worked for Philco in Philadelphia, PA. From 1961 until his retirement in 1991, he was employed at the General Electric Space Division in King of Prussia, PA.

He is survived by his wife of 49 years, Helen, and their children: George Billings and his wife, Trudy, of Mt. Pleasant, SC, Jennifer Walge and her husband, Walter, of Tracys Landing, MD, Michael Billings and his wife, Lora, of Chatham, NJ, and four grandchildren: Tyler, Amanda, Jack, and Tighe.
