John R. Clements, 67, of Betterton, MD, passed away on Saturday, August 19, 2023.

John was born to Elizabeth and Robert Clements in Baltimore, MD, and grew up in Ellicott City. He attended Mount St. Joseph High School in Baltimore and married Eileen Tipton in 1976. John went to work at his father's appliance business at a young age and remained there until 1995 at which time he switched career paths and worked for his brother-in-law managing a deli at Walter Reed Army Hospital. In 2001, John joined Williams Co. as a gas pipeline technician and worked there until retirement in 2019.

John loved spending time with family, cooking, and entertaining friends, being the neighborhood "fix-it" man and tooling around Betterton in his 1969 MGB, fondly named "Moneypenny," with his faithful grand-dog George by his side.

John is predeceased by his parents and beloved son, Matthew Clements. He is survived by his wife, Eileen (of almost 47 years); daughter, Jennifer Clements; sons, Jonathon (Jessica) Clements and Benjamin (Carrington) Clements; and four loving grandchildren, Cole (Adde), Samantha, Holden, and Cabell.

He is also survived by his siblings, Kathleen (Vernon) Tate, Ann (William)

Boleyn, Mary Clare Ayers, and Julie Hetzel, as well as many nieces, nephews, and close family members.

“ The Clements family was an inextricably large part of my childhood. They were my families' next door neighbors. As much as rural neighbors can be next door.! John and I became "best-buddies" from the time we first met. We'd explore nature together, both on foot and on our dirt bikes in the back woods & fields. . I recall once on Saturday Morning when we were 8 and 10 years old, John & I “went exploring” on our own into the depths of our backyards, nearly causing our parents to have heart-attacks as they had fanned out to find out where we had gone. I recall hearing their frantic calling out to us, YES, we were BAD, sometimes not so destructively, like when John discovered how to extract the decks off of the lawn mowing tractors. You must understand that we both had been given clearance to be the ‘official lawn mowers” of our neighboring lots from as early as we were in our single digit ages. Man-o-man, by the time that we were in our early-mid teens we could & did wield a tractor over any type of terrain.

I fondly recall our weeknight trips to the pool hall after my father had died. I also remember being thrilled to be the passenger in his '72 Oldsmobile Cutlass, on our many trips to the ocean...! I specifically remember on one of our trips to go ‘downy ocean’ in the van that he would have gotten in his late-teens, perhaps when he was 17 years old, because I know that I was nearly of driving age (15). I had my “learners-permit” and John allowed me to drive his van all that way, to Ocean City, as he and other friends were passengers riding in the back. John, in essence, turned into something like a big brother to me..... It was nice to hear that John grew into such a family man from the eulogies given about him.

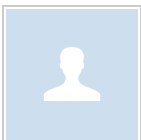
