John N. Funk, Jr., passed away peacefully on July 4, 2015, at the age of 91.

John was born on February 3, 1924, in Manhattan, NY. He was raised in the Bronx, NY. John graduated from Christopher Columbus High School in the Bronx. He enlisted in the Army Air Corps and became a B-24 pilot during World War II. After the war, he married Virginia DeSesa on December 28, 1946. He studied general engineering and graduated from Davis & Elkins College in Elkins, WV.

In December 1950, he took his first and only job with the Joseph E. Seagrams Company working at the Calvert Distillery in Baltimore, MD. This began a distinguished forty-year career with the company. Over the years, he was promoted, and they moved with the company to Louisville, KY, Lawrenceburg, Indiana and New York City. In his later position in international operations, it enabled him to travel all over the world. He traveled to Europe, Russia, and Southeast Asia. On many occasions, Virginia accompanied him. His last assignment took them to Shanghai, China, for three years.

After retirement, they moved to St. Michaels, MD. In 2013, they moved to the Londonderry Retirement Community in Easton. Over the many years, John and Virginia made many friends everywhere they went. He enjoyed gardening, baseball and swing music, especially Frank Sinatra, Tony Bennett,

and the big bands. He and Virginia loved to travel, especially to see old friends and family.

John is survived by his wife of 68 years, Virginia; his son, John III, and daughter-in-law, Barbara; granddaughters, Carly and Kelsey and his son, Jim and daughter-in-law, Elizabeth.

A visitation will be held on Thursday, July 9, 2015, from 4 - 6 p.m. at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., 200 S. Harrison St., Easton. A funeral liturgy will be celebrated on Friday, July 10, 2015 at 11 a.m. at St. Joseph Catholic Church, 13209 Church Lane, Cordova, MD 21625. Burial will follow in St. Joseph Church Cemetery.

He carried himself with an offhand elegance, and impressed me as one of the few men who might actually keep his head when all around him were losing theirs.
